### Summary

The Open House was held from 7:00-7:15 PM for attendees to browse the storm water and watershed education displays.

Noel Mullett, Wayne County, announced two upcoming streambank stabilization workshops to be held in lower Huron River Watershed communities: on 5/23 in Rockwood; and 6/4 at Brownstown Community Center.

At 7:15 PM LHRWIC Chair Roy Schrameck welcomed attendees. Roy gave background on why the LHRWIC is developing a watershed management plan (WMP) and where the group is in the process. Roy and Elizabeth Riggs, HRWC, presented the efforts to date of the LHRWIC in developing its WMP, current conditions of the watershed and described the next steps for the committee. Attendees received the LHRWIC's current Goals and Objectives for the Lower Huron River Watershed. A brief Q&A session followed.

Leonard Mannausa, a resident from Brownstown, expressed his concern about the increasing shallowness at the mouth of the Huron River, and shared an update on his efforts with the Army Corps of Engineers and Huron-Clinton Metroparks Association to employ dredging and re-channeling of the river as means to address this concern. Leonard suggested that the LHRWIC obtain the "John Glenn Report" and speak with Les Wiggins at the Army Corps of Engineers, Detroit District.

Attendees completed a 1-page evaluation about the public meeting.
