

HRWC Watershed Resident Outreach Survey Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

Any resident of the United States may take the survey and provide contact information for eligibility to win a prize. Determination of whether a participant meets these criteria shall be under the supervision of the Huron River Watershed Council whose decisions shall be final in all matters relating to this campaign. Completed surveys are counted only for those who fill out the survey questionnaire, submit the survey response online and submit their full contact information as required in the additional form provided.

Limit one entry per email address.

A \$200 gift card, one each, will be awarded to five (5) randomly drawn entrants from those who complete their entry (see above) by 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time ("ET") on Sunday, January 1, 2023.
